1. Buon Amici House White £14.95

Specially selected by Kamillo for your enjoyment.
“I think a good house wine says a lot about a place”.

2. Echeverria, Chardonnay, Curico Valley, Chile £17.95

A complex chardonnay with aromas of ripe peaches and pineapples.

3. Saint Clair Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand £18.95

A light bodied, dry, crisp wine with typical Marlborough flavours of gooseberry, guava, nettles and a hint of honeysuckle and lime.

4. Rioja Bianco, Spain £18.95

A delicious, balanced fresh white Rioja.

5. Gavi di Gavi, DOCG, Italy £20.95

6. Dinari del Duca Grilla, Sicilia £17.95

Rich and well balanced, with a fruity floral bouquet.

7. Falanghina IGT Beneventano, Italy £18.50

This wine is dry with undertones of ripe white peaches.

8. Chablis, Domaine Jean Goulley & Fils £26.95

Clean fruit, typical fresh mineral notes on the nose of the palate.

9. Sancerre £26.95

Incredibly stylish.

10. Greco de Tufo DOCG, Italy £25.95

Lemon and grapefruit coloured with a clean dry finish. Exceptional value

Fresh and fruity with an off-dry finish.

11. Buon Amici House Red £14.95

12. Head over Heels Black Shiraz, Australia £18.95

The palate shows intense berry and rich fruit cake characters underpinned by layers of coffee and toasty oak that carries through to a lovely soft finish.

13. Echeverria Merlot Reserva, Chile £18.95

This is a wine full of juicy, ripe and soft Merlot character, with lovely intensity and a long finish.

11. Tierra Antica Pinot Noir Reserva, Bio Bio, Chile £18.95

Ripe strawberries with balanced vanilla from oak ageing; classic Pinot flavours, very fine.

12. Don David Reserva Malbec, Argentina £18.95

Rich and a complex flavour with a very long and attractive aftertastes due to its round and full ripe tannins. Ideal with spicy meat dishes.

13. Nipozzano Chianti Rufina Reserva DOCG, Italy £28.95

The palate is powerful with sweet, evolved tannins, harmonious and elegant.

14. Indio Montipulciano d'Abruzzo DOC, Italy £18.95

Full bodied but smooth with a typical liquorice aftertaste and a bouquet reminiscent of wild berries.

15. Barolo 'Patres' DOCG, Italy £31.95

Smooth with sweet fruit and balanced tannins. An approachable style of Barolo.

16. Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOC, Italy £40.95

This wine has a full bouquet showing vanilla and sweet fruits with a velvety mouth feel and rich, raisiny flavours.

17. Catelgiocondo Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Italy £59.95

Concentrated and rich, well structured, this is a fine aristocratic wine.

18. Rioja Gran Reserva, Spain £24.95

Traditionally styled Rioja, smooth, ripe and subtle with the added complexity of vanilla and well integrated tannins in a long finish.
